Last Will and Testament of Rachel G Blades (1st Landing, Maiden Powell)
Pages 387 and 388 from Worcester County Court House, Maryland Jan 1990.
Sent to Donald R. Landing by Fay Brooks, volunteer at Worcester County Library and Worcester County Court House.

In the name of God Amen I Rachel G Blades of Worcester County in the State of Maryland being sick and weak in body but of sound and disposing mind memory and understanding considering the certainty of death and the uncertainty of the time thereof and being desirous to settle my worldly affairs and thereby be the better prepared to leave this world when it shall please God to call me hence do therefore make and publish this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following to wit.

First and principally, I commit my soul into the hands of Almighty God and my body to the earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executor hereafter named; and after my debts and funeral charges are paid I devise and bequeath as follows

Item 1st I give and bequeath unto my Grand children the children of my son Samuel T Landing to with Cordelia Long wife of Wm J Long Isbella Landing George Landing Mary Landing Samuel Landing William Landing and Emma Landing the sum of Fifty cents to be paid to them by my Executor out of my Estate.

Item 2nd I devise and bequeath all the rest and residue of my Estate both real and personal to be divided between my son George W Landing and my grand children children of my Daughter Peggy Webb and the Children of my son James Landing in the following manner to wit, to my son George W Landing one third to my Said Daughter Peggys children John Webb and Edward Webb and one third and to my son James Landings children Francis Ellis wife and Samuel Ellis Mary E Ellis wife of George Ellis and James Landing one third to them their heirs and assigns forever.

And lastly, I do hereby constitute and appoint my son George W Landing to be sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament revoking and annulling all formers wills by me --- hereto made ratifying and confirming this and none other to be my last Will and Testament.

In Testimony whereof I have hereto set my hand and affixed my seal this thirteenth day of April in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and sixty

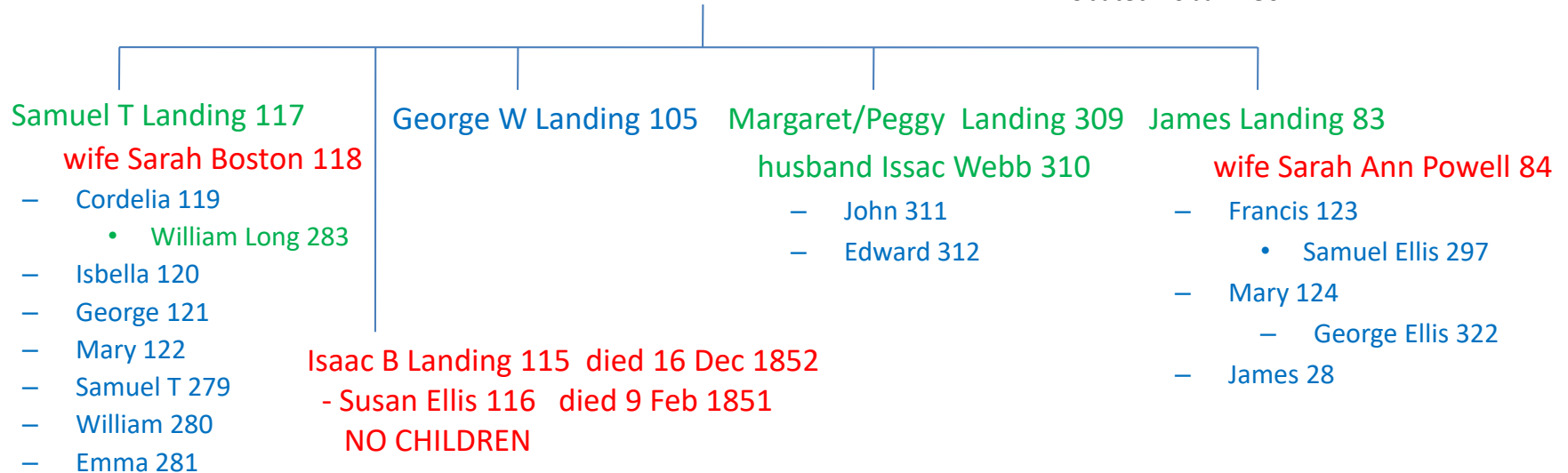

- No direct mention of Samuel in will, appears he dies 1857-1860
- No mention of Samuel's wife in will, in 1870 Federal Census, Sally Landing listed as "lady" was living with daughter Cordelia

Margaret dies 9 Feb 1851

James dies before 25 Feb 1847
Sarah Ann Powell remarries
26 Jul 1851
