Sealed with our seals, and dated this *2nd* day of *October* — One Thousand Eight Hundred and Twenty *two*

The condition of the above obligation is such, that whereas there is a marriage shortly intended to be had and solemnized between the above bound

Esquire daughter of Robert Campbell and Sarah Campbell

Now therefore if there be no lawful cause to obstruct said Marriage, then the above obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
