Sealed with our seals, and dated this *25<sup>th</sup>* day of *December* One Thousand Eight Hundred and Twenty *two*

The condition of the above obligation is such, that whereas there is a marriage shortly intended to be had and solemnized between the above bound *Isaac Lewis* and *Sophia Landring* daughter of *Michael*

Now therefore if there be no lawful cause to obstruct said Marriage, then the above obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
