Know all men by these presents that I **Thomas Landon** of Worcester County and State of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and ten dollars Current money to me in hand paid by John Stevenson of the county and state aforesaid at and before the unsealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof I the **Landon** do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained & sold and by these presents do absolutely grant bargain & sell unto the said Stevenson his executors administrators and assigns, one young mare one carriage two cows three yearlings one yoke of old oxen one hundred bushels of corn six stacks of fodder two barrels of pork three beds of furniture one cart six ???? one handmade one case of drawers one block now in my possession To Have and To Hold the said goods & Chattels to the said John Stevenson his executors, administrators and assigns forever and I the said **Thomas Landon** for myself my heirs executors administrators and assigns the above mentioned property and every part and parcel there of will and shall warrant and forever ???? by these presents Provided nevertheless that in case I the said **Landon** shall pay and satisfy to the said Stevenson or to his executors administrators ???? the following notes of hand viz one assigned to said Stevenson from Edward Lauibden bearing date the 26 day of October 1819 for the sum of \$ 18:70 one from the said **Landon** to said Stevenson ???? ???? ???? ???? for the sum \$ 32:00 one other from the same to the same and dated the 9 th day of September 1280 for the sum of \$ 54:19 with Interest on each note from their respective dates on on before the first day of January next ensuing; then this Bill of Sale and every matter and thing therein expressed shall be void and of none effect, it being the true intent and meaning thereof that the said goods & chattels are mortgaged by me the said **Landon** to secure to the said Stevenson the payment of the money aforesaid. In witness whereof I the said **Thomas Landon** have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this twenty seventh day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty one.
